

IPPS 6 Packer Award



Great opportunity for new horticulturalists to attend a top industry conference in the Netherlands

Every year the European region of International Plant Propagators Society puts on a jammed packed conference, where by six budding new horticulturalists (six packers) get to experience the conference free of charge. This year promises to be another fantastic conference entitled 'Built to adapt' at Hotel Keyser Golden Tulip in Breda, Netherlands on $10^{th} - 12^{th}$ October.

The conference will cover key issues that the horticulture industry faces today, as such the demand from retailers to have complete traceability of the crop's lifecycle and the threat to plant health from imported stock. During the conference we will get to visit Florensis which is one of the largest plug plant producers in Europe, along with Special Plant Zundert BV, an innovative grower specialising in Green Tea.

As a six packer you get to meet industry experts, hear the about the last technological advances and visit some of the top nurseries in Breda. In return for helping with different aspects of the conference, as such photography, conference registration and audio assistance.

Each six packer who attends the conference will be interviewed for the chance to win an exchange program to the Southern region of North America, where they will attend their conference.

The six packer award really opened my eyes to the full scale the production industry, how efficiently seeds can be sown, crops irrigate and the competition we face from the Netherlands. Application Form 2018

Entry Requirements:

- 1. Anyone new to working in horticulture or studying to enter the horticultural industry.
- 2. Must be based in Europe.
- 3. Although the candidate can apply directly to the IPPS, nominations and or approval should also come from either the candidate's employer or tutor, whichever is more applicable.
- 4. Must be willing to assist the conference organisers throughout the duration of the conference and may be asked to carry out certain duties which may include: photography, report writing, blogging and writing press releases, helping at registration, managing the audio visual equipment, managing groups on the nursery visits etc.
- 5. Successful candidates must produce a word document detailing their experience on the conference, noting information which have learnt from interacting with the conference delegates, watching the presentations and visiting the nurseries. This document only needs to be one side of A4 and should include images.

The Prize:

- Six selected candidates will be invited to attend the European Annual Conference which this year is being held in Breda, Netherlands - dates: 10th – 12th October.
- 2. The full cost of board and lodging will be covered (including the night before the conference 9th October) and all conference fees will be waived, with a €50 contribution towards travel costs.
- 3. The selected candidates will also gain the opportunity to apply for the 2019 International Exchange award. Hereby, one 6 packer candidate will be chosen to travel to & attend the annual conference in the Southern region of North America. The application will take the form of undergoing a short interview with a team of professionals at the 2018 annual conference. The candidate that impresses the team the most will receive the major travel award. Once again all reasonable travel costs will be covered along with full board and lodging at the conference and a waiving of conference fees.

How to apply:

- 1. The candidates should complete the form below and return it, together with a written summary/resume (email acceptable) of their involvement in the industry so far and what they want to achieve within the industry in the future.
- 2. The deadline for applications is 28th April 2018.
- Applications will be inspected by a team of industry professionals. There are 6 places available and only offered if the IPPS requirements and standards are met. The selected candidates will be notified by 18th May 2018, by E-mail of the outcome of their application.
