Terms and Conditions

Each year three scholarships may be awarded, each up to the value of \$1,600.

The recipient will receive \$600 at the start of the project, and \$1,000 following the successful completion and presentation of the project at a New Zealand Region IPPS conference. IPPS will pay for the recipient's conference fee (excluding accommodation, travel, and non-conference meals). It is intended that the recipient may use the \$1,600 scholarship to pay for those items not covered by the conference fee.

Eligibility

- Applicants for the **Plant Production Scholarship** must be a New Zealand citizen or hold permanent New Zealand residency.
- Applications will only be accepted using the IPPS Plant Production Scholarship Application Form and all sections must be completed.
- Scholarship recipients agree to allow IPPS to publicise the recipient's name, photograph and brief biographical details in promotional material and the news media.
- For those scholarship recipients carrying out the interview and video project, they agree that IPPS will own all project video footage produced and may use this material on the IPPS website and other internet based sites. Your name will be credited to any material used.
