Attached is the announcement for the Southern Region-International Plant Propagators' Student Competition. Research paper titles are due 15 August and papers are due by 1 September. Three students will be selected to present oral presentations and three students for poster presentations at the meeting. In past years, the student's have reported on several aspects of horticulture – macro and micropropagation, rooting hormones, new substrates, herbicide movement in runoff water, marketing, and weed control in nursery production.

Three awards, \$1000, \$500, and \$250 will be given to first, second, and third place paper presenters, respectively. This is a great opportunity for students to present their research and meet many of the leading growers in the Southeast. In addition, the society awards a travel grant up to \$500 for each student presenting an oral presentation. Also, three additional student papers will be selected to receive a \$500 travel grant to support the student in presenting a poster in the Poster Session. Conference dates and location change each year. Please check IPPS.org for details
